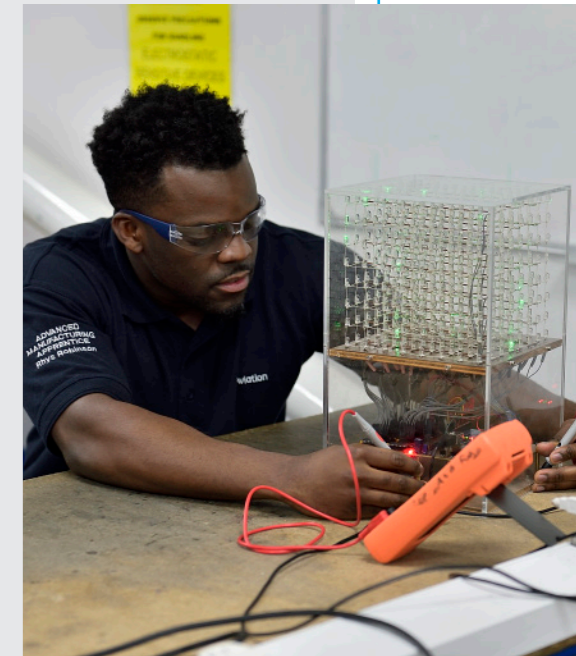

These are the three parts of your Apprenticeship

1. Competency - this is the practical hands on element of the programme
2. Knowledge - this is the theoretical part of the programme
3. Behaviour - this is part of the programme that builds your work ethic and ensures you are equipped with the correct attitude and behaviour to perform well in your place of work.

All three parts of the programme must be achieved in order to qualify for an apprenticeship completion certificate.
